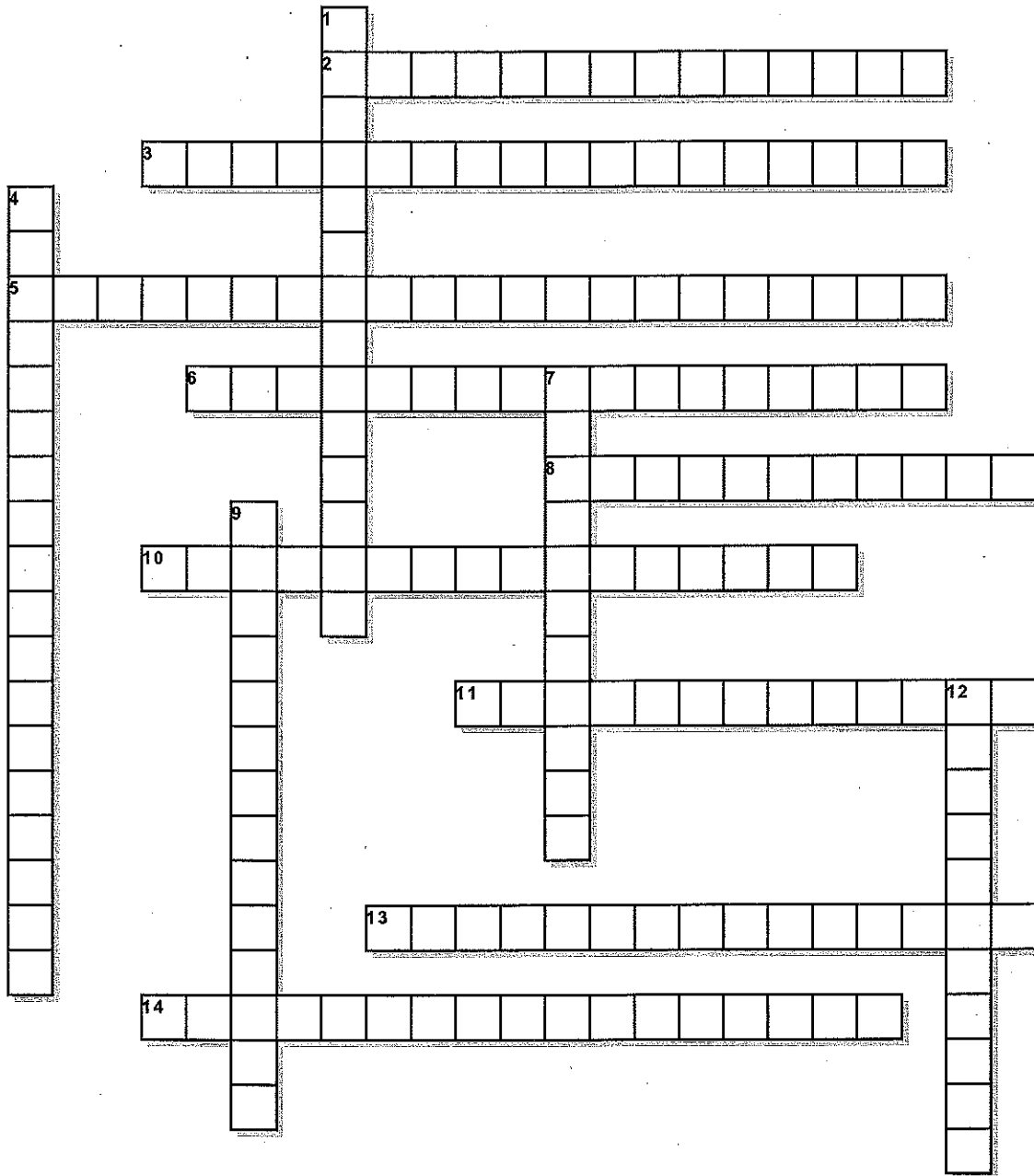


U.S. Global Expansion 1880-1917

- 13 Puerto Rican leader who fought for independence for Puerto Rico.
- 14 First queen of the Hawaiian Islands.
